Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the Panola County Board of Supervisors Board Room, 151 Public Square, Batesville, MS 38601 until 10:00 A.M. local time, Friday, March 7, 2025 and shortly thereafter publicly opened and read for:

The scope of work for the site work package consists of site preparation and flatwork. A minimal amount of fine grading will be required to prepare the site for concrete work including curb and gutter, sidewalk and concrete pavement as well as placement of asphalt pavement with crushed stone subbase. In addition to the flatwork, a small amount- approximately 150 LF – of concrete pipe is to be installed along with erosion control measures.

Contract time is 75 Calendar Days. Contractor shall commence work on or before a date to be stipulated in the Notice to Proceed.

Panola County Board of Supervisors reserves the right to waive any irregularities and to reject any and all bids if considered not in the best interest of Panola County Board of Supervisors.

Bidders are hereby notified that any proposal accompanied by letters qualifying in any manner the condition under which the proposal is tendered will be considered an irregular bid, and such proposals may not be considered in making the award.
